

A Note from your CEO Cybersecurity

With the recent cyber attacks on the Colonial Pipeline and Kaseya software, I've received questions about REA's vulnerabilities and steps taken to do our best to avoid one here.

Our risks are primarily in three areas - wholesale power supply and transmission, local distribution

operations related to equipment in the field, and our internal computer systems and information technology.

The most significant risk at the local level to reliability of service is an actual physical attack of some sort that occurs at a substation. Most of our newer equipment is fitted with electronic controls that communicate over a wide area network. However, all of the equipment used to distribute power locally can quickly be removed from the network and placed under the manual control of REA's linemen. In addition, our wholesale power provider, Great River Energy, manages cybersecurity for the monitoring software located at the network's hub in Elk River.

Great River Energy has responsibility for all computer and electronic control of generating assets and transmission lines that provide power to REA. "We're seeing an increase in sophisticated hacking operations," said Marc Child, the information security program manager at REA's wholesale power provider Great River Energy. "In our partnership with the Department of Homeland Security, we're hearing hackers likened to terrorists. It's gaining national and international attention, especially among what we consider as essential infrastructure: electricity, banking, and public works."

Critical infrastructure companies, including REA, have mandatory minimum standards for cybersecurity.

Cybersecurity practices and procedures are regularly reviewed and updated to ensure they're effective against a cyberattack.

"At Great River Energy, we're required by the North American Electric Reliability Corporation to ensure our cyber assets are secured," Child said. "This means that we're required to take necessary steps to ensure the grid and our member data is safe and secure. Cybersecurity is critical to what Great River Energy does as it maintains and operates the grid."

Finally, we rely on several providers of software for our internal business processes. While few of these software applications have a public-facing internet portal, we work closely with these developers to maintain all levels of security. Our employees participate in routine training on the latest cybersecurity threats and are exposed to simulated phishing attacks to increase awareness. Unfortunately, ransomware is just one click away, but I feel we are taking all the steps we can to protect ourselves. Our most utilized internal software application is provided by the National Information Solutions Cooperative (NISC). This application has a public portal (SmartHub) that utilizes both internal servers here in Alexandria and a cloud-based service to help manage risk.

Members can safely use SmartHub to manage their accounts, monitor electric use, and, if you choose, pay your bill. All SmartHub passwords stored in our database are encrypted, not in plain text. REA employees do not have access to passwords. If a member forgets their password, they are required to answer a series of validation questions before entering a new password.

Ransomware and other cyber threats are on the rise. We have ongoing communication with our software and hardware vendors to assess risk, plan, and follow industry best practices to protect ourselves as best we can. Fortunately, we are a smaller organization with fewer access points than the large businesses we hear about in the news. While the risk can never be reduced to zero, I'm confident we are taking prudent steps to minimize our exposure.

- » Reviewed the Financial Report for May 2021. kWh sales were over budget for May but under budget year-to-date. Electric service revenue dollars are over budget for the year due to the inclusion of pass-through PCA charges from GRE.
- » The Member Advisory Council will meet on Tuesday, August 24, for the first time since February 2020 due to Covid restrictions.
- » Reviewed results of the Aquanta water heating control pilot program program. Aquanta devices will be deployed over a four-year timetable, completing the project by the end of 2025.
- » Reviewed the District Meetings and upcoming Annual Meeting on August 19. The Board's consensus was to consider holding future District Meetings and the Annual Meeting late spring or early summer.
- » REA received a \$1,000 donation from Great River Energy for the Operation Round Up program.
